



FACT SHEET: MOSER

WHERE

Summit County, north of Silverthorne, Blue River Basin

WATER RIGHTS CHANGED

- Two water rights out of the Peabody #1 Ditch, diverting from Boulder Creek, with priority dates of 1904 and 1915.
- By a 2011 water court decree, these water rights now include instream flow use but hold their senior priority

STREAMS IMPROVED

A. *Boulder Creek*

- Three stream miles of flows added
- Almost 4 cfs put back into river in the summer
- Home to brook trout and a tributary of the Blue River

B. *Blue River*

- Eleven miles of flows added
- Almost 4 cfs put back into river in the summer
- Gold Medal Waters for brown and rainbow trout

CONSUMPTIVE USE DOWNSTREAM

Colorado River Water Conservation District owns the historic consumptive use of the changed water rights for use downstream of Green Mountain Reservoir.

COST

\$130,500

- Paid for by grants from the Gates Family Foundation, the Colorado Conservation Trust, and a loan from The Nature Conservancy.
